Half day tours

Camden Town

See the bohemian side of London in this fashionable central London district. Famous for its eclectic markets, diverse music scene and vibrant street art, Camden is a great place to explore. With its range of hand-made and vintage stalls and shops, there really is treasure to be found! You'll get guided around the area and given some time to explore the curiosities on offer.

The British Museum

Spend your time exploring one of the most famous museums in the world. Egyptian mummies, artwork by Rembrandt and Michelangelo, and the Rosetta Stone are just some of the incredible pieces you'll see as you wander this 265-year-old museum.

Covent Garden

Discover one of London's most vibrant districts, where history, culture, and entertainment come alive. From street performers and boutique shops to the historic market halls and world-class dining, Covent Garden offers something for everyone.

Natural History Museum

Get up close to dinosaur skeletons, rare gems and interactive exhibits whilst our tour guides point out interesting exhibits in this enormous museum. Visit the main atrium for a look at a full-size blue whale skeleton, take a photo with a triceratops, or learn about the formation of the solar system.

Portobello Road & Notting Hill

A popular location for movies, this beautiful area of London is home to the famous Portobello Markets. A lively atmosphere of street performers and market stalls sat amongst beautiful buildings makes this a great trip out. You'll get a guided walk through the area before having a little free time to explore the stalls and shops at your own pace.

British Library & Granary Square

This excursion offers a balanced mix of culture and contemporary London life. You'll visit the British Library to discover historic manuscripts and world-famous documents, then head to Granary Square, a lively public space known for its fountains, modern architecture and relaxed atmosphere.

Oxford Street Shopping and Oxford Circus

What trip to London would be complete without spending some time shopping on the world-famous Oxford Street? You'll get the opportunity to visit iconic shops, watch street entertainers and soak up the atmosphere of one of London's most visited streets. A great time to pick up some souvenirs for friends and family back home.

Full day tours

Sightseeing Tour 1: Westminster

Our tour begins in leafy Green Park before arriving at the gates of Buckingham Palace, the King's official residence, where you'll get time for some great photos. You'll stroll through the picturesque St. James's Park on the way to Westminster to see Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament, and Westminster Abbey. From there you'll pass Downing Street, the home of the Prime Minister, and the Cenotaph before reaching the bustling Trafalgar Square. In the afternoon you'll get to explore the world-renowned National Gallery, home to masterpieces by Van Gogh, Da Vinci, and Turner. The tour finishes with The Royal Cavalry Horse Guard Inspection, where you'll get to see some of the King's guards and their horses come out for a march and inspection in their finest uniforms.

Full Day Excursion: Brighton

Hop on the train to England's sunny south coast and discover the charm of Brighton. Wander through the maze of boutique shops and cafés in The Lanes, then head to the lively seafront. Your visit includes entry to the 125-year-old Brighton Pier, where you can stroll out over the waves, take in sweeping sea views, indulge in classic treats like candy floss, or even brave the rollercoaster for a thrill!

Full Day Excursion: Oxford with Official Guided Tour

Spend a full day exploring the beautiful sights of Oxford on this full day walking tour of one of the world's oldest universities and surrounding city. You'll be guided by an Oxford University alumni, who will show you everything from the world-famous architectural jewels of the Bodleian Library, Radcliffe Camera and the Bridge of Sighs to the often-missed wonders hidden down small alleyways. Full Day Excursion: Cambridge with Punting

Sightseeing Tour 2: Tower Hill and Southwark

On your second tour you'll start with views of the mighty Tower of London, where centuries of royal history and the Crown Jewels are housed. You'll also get to see Shakespeare's Globe Theatre, a faithful reconstruction of the playwright's famous playhouse. We then take you across Millennium Bridge and finish at the magnificent St Paul's Cathedral, one of London's most awe-inspiring landmarks. This walk blends history, culture, and unforgettable views along the river.

Spend the day testing your thrill-seeking limits at one of the largest theme parks in the UK. You'll get private coach transport to and from the park, and get an entire day of rollercoasters, rides and entertainment.
